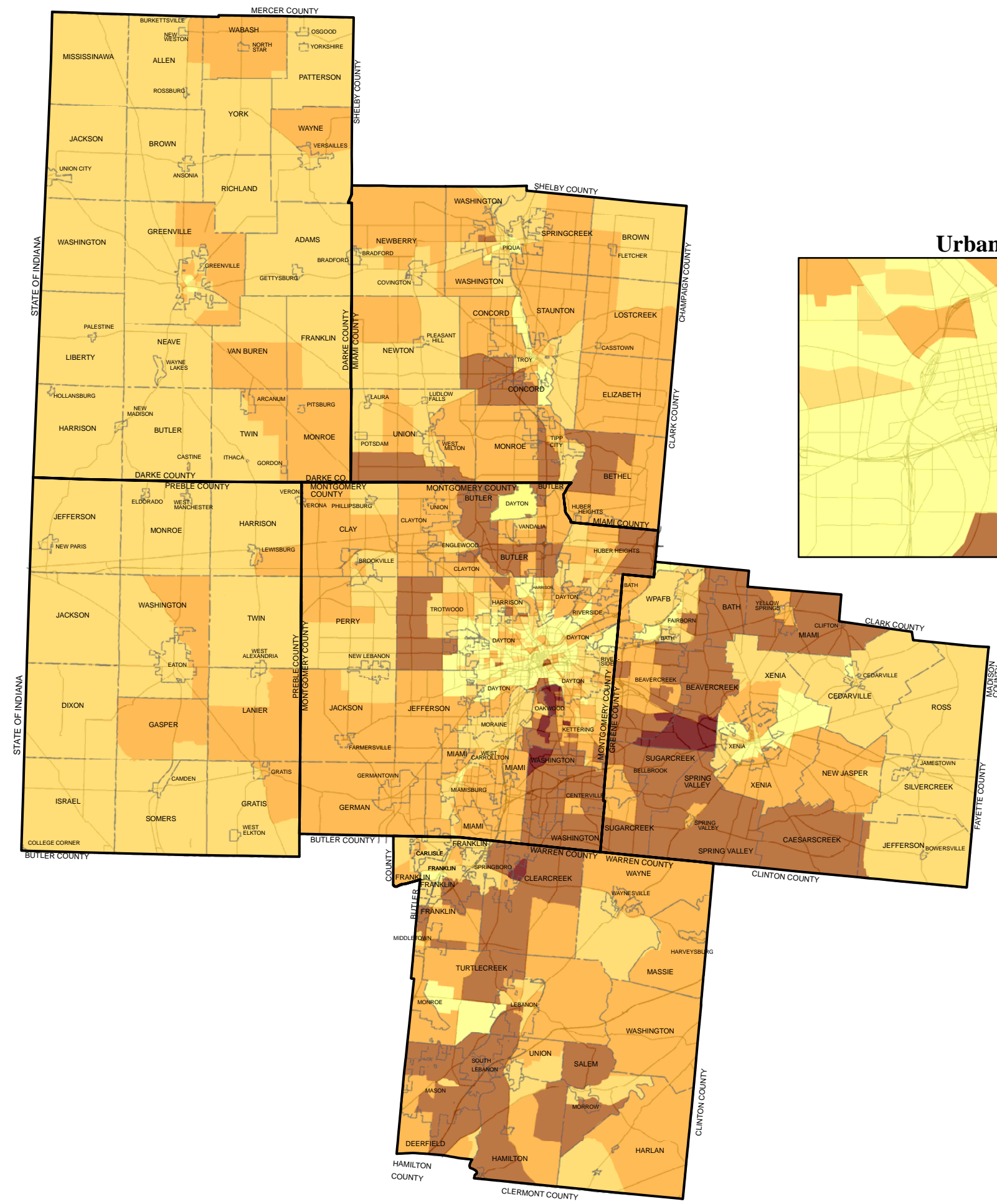


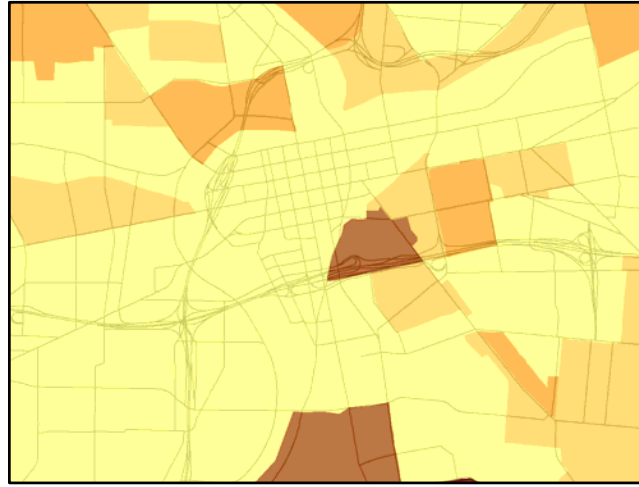

Urban Core

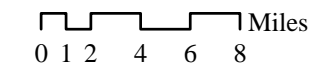


Per Capita Income by Block Group

-  Medium (\$20,517.01 - \$27,907.00)
-  Medium High (\$27,907.01 - \$44,527.00)
-  High (\$44,527.01 - \$82,937.00)

Per Capita Income is the mean income computed for every man, woman, and child in a particular group. It is derived by dividing the total income of a particular group by the total population in that group.
