



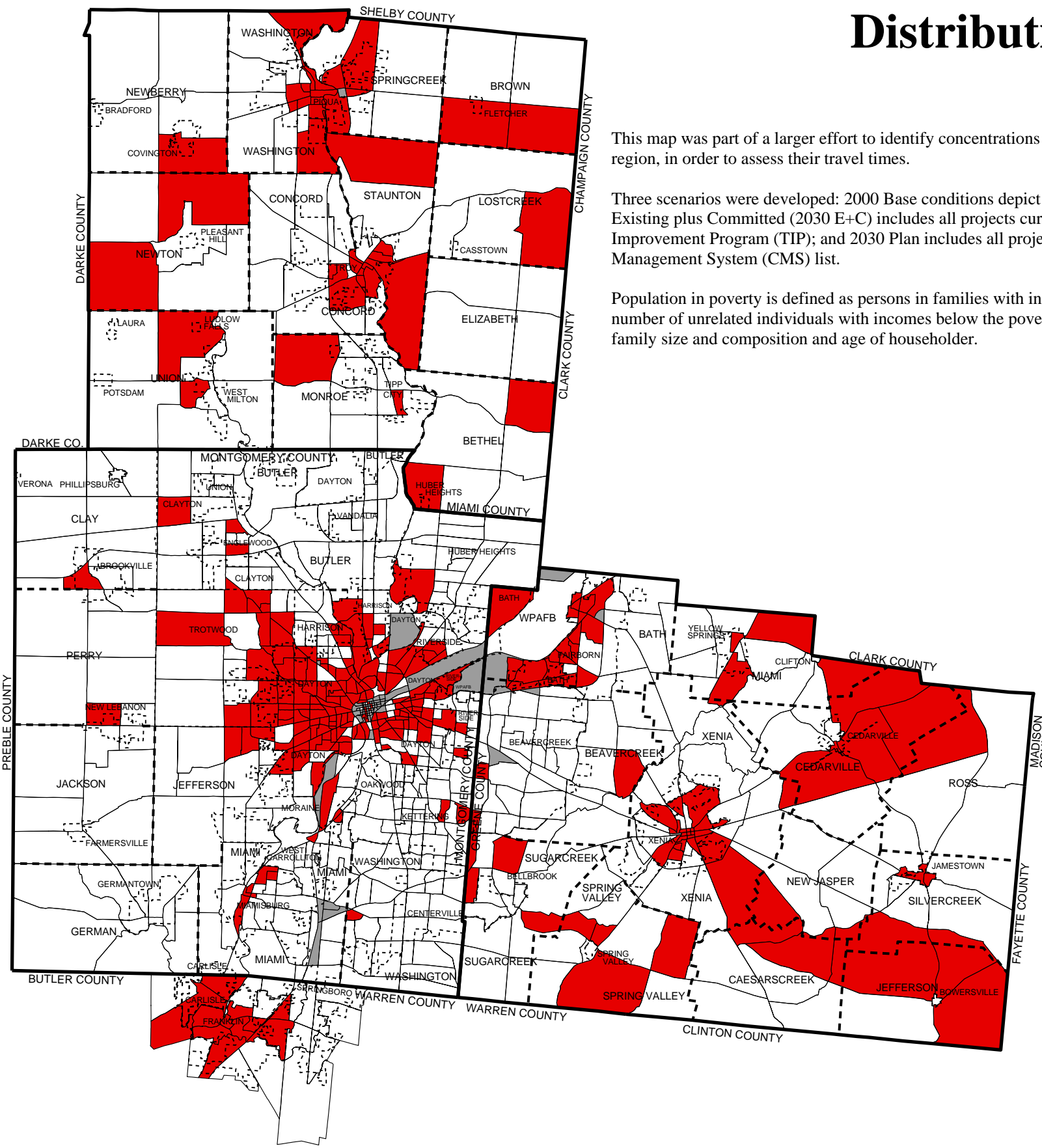

# Distribution of People in Poverty

This map was part of a larger effort to identify concentrations of disadvantaged populations in the region, in order to assess their travel times.

Three scenarios were developed: 2000 Base conditions depict the existing transportation network; 2030 Existing plus Committed (2030 E+C) includes all projects currently funded in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and 2030 Plan includes all projects currently in the Congestion Management System (CMS) list.

Population in poverty is defined as persons in families with income below the poverty threshold, and the number of unrelated individuals with incomes below the poverty thresholds. Poverty thresholds vary by family size and composition and age of householder.



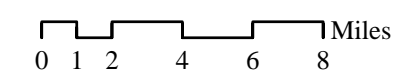

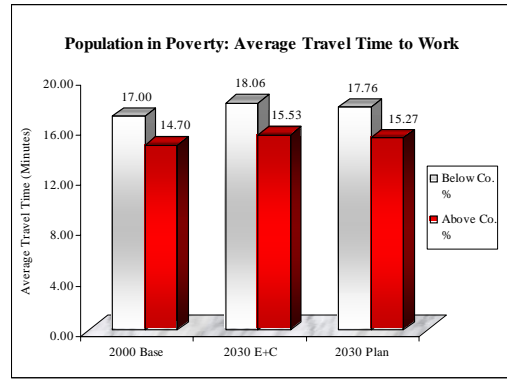
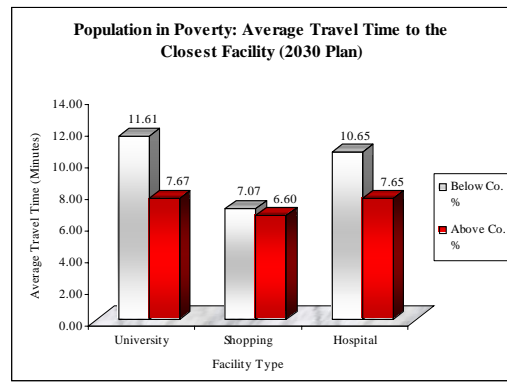
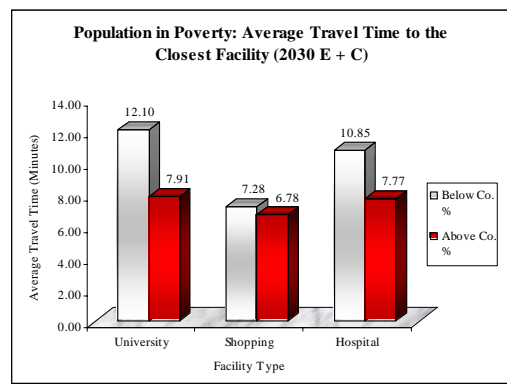
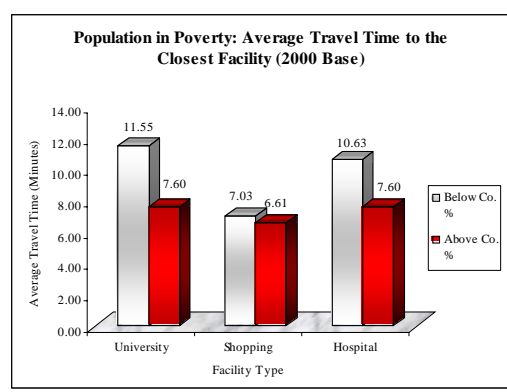
## Poverty Percentage by County
