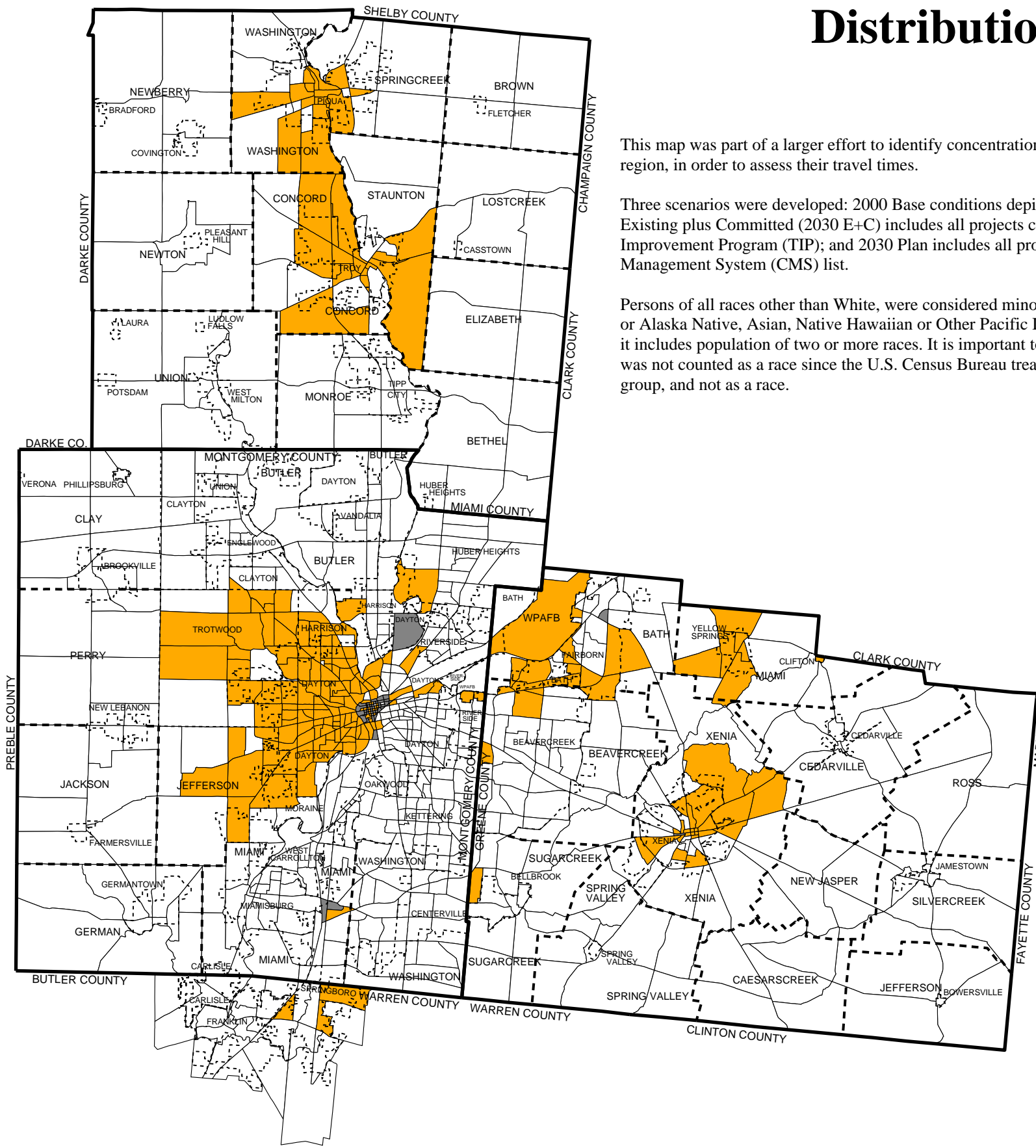

Distribution of Minority Population



This map was part of a larger effort to identify concentrations of disadvantaged populations in the region, in order to assess their travel times.

Three scenarios were developed: 2000 Base conditions depict the existing transportation network; 2030 Existing plus Committed (2030 E+C) includes all projects currently funded in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and 2030 Plan includes all projects currently in the Congestion Management System (CMS) list.

Persons of all races other than White, were considered minorities. This includes Black, American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, or some other race alone. Further, it includes population of two or more races. It is important to note that the population of Hispanic origin was not counted as a race since the U.S. Census Bureau treats persons of Hispanic origin as an ethnic group, and not as a race.

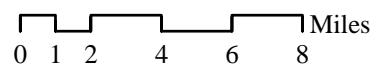
Minority Population by County

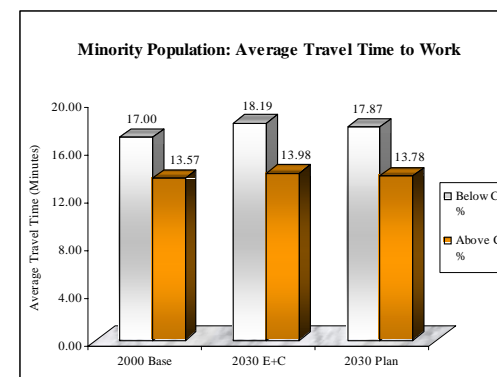
