

## SECTION 3

### Accomplishments

Biennially, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission prepares and updates the TIP in cooperation with state and local officials, local and regional transit operators and other affected transportation and regional planning and implementing agencies. As a result of this cooperative effort, the TIP acts as the primary mechanism for implementation of the LRTP, which was adopted by the MVRPC Board of Directors on May 1, 2008. The area's progress in implementing the highway and transit elements of the LRTP is summarized in this section along with other highway improvements and calendar year (CY) 2009-2010 highway expenditures.

### 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan Project Accomplishments

The LRTP serves as a guide indicating when various projects, that are required for optimal functionality of the regional transportation network, could be implemented given realistic funding availability. The implementation of the LRTP is a cooperative and continuous process that involves MVRPC's Board of Directors, local jurisdictions that are directly involved in project implementation, the Ohio and U.S. Departments of Transportation, and citizens of the region.

### Highway Accomplishments

The MVRPC Board of Directors adopted the **2030 Long Range Transportation Plan** in May of 2008. Future updates of the TIP will include narrative describing implementation status of the LRTP highway projects.

Table 3.1A and 3.1B list 186 highway projects sold, completed, or under construction in CY2009 and Table 3.2A and 3.2B lists 195 highway projects sold, completed, or under construction in CY2010.

### Transit Accomplishments

The MVRPC Board of Directors adopted the **2030 Long Range Transportation Plan** in May of 2008. Future updates of the TIP will include narrative describing implementation status of the LRTP transit projects.

### Review of CY2009-2010 Highway Expenditures

Since the Board's adoption of the SFY2008-2011 TIP, several revisions have been made with amendments or deletions initiated by local jurisdictions, MVRPC or ODOT.

Table 3.3A, *CY2009 Highway Expenditures* and Table 3.3B, *CY2010 Highway Expenditures*, show the amount of expenditures which occurred in 2009 and 2010 within all the funding categories as shown in the Explanation of Abbreviations table preceding Table 4.1.

In 2009 the total amount expended on highway projects in the three-county area totaled \$156,034,011. Federal expenditures accounted for \$80,329,000 (51.48%) of the total expenditures in the region. State funds accounted for \$6,816,000 (4.37%) of the total funds expended. Approximately \$20,711,000 (13.27%) in local funds was also spent in combination with State and Federal funds. An estimated additional \$48,178,011 (30.88%) was also spent by local governments on roadway improvements.

The 2010 total amount expended on highway projects in the MVRPC MPO area totaled \$173,171,957. Federal expenditures accounted for \$121,781,000 (70.32%) of the total expenditures in the region. State funds accounted for \$10,473,000 (6.05%) of the total funds expended. Approximately \$18,137,000 (10.47%) in local funds was also spent in combination with State and Federal funds. An estimated additional \$22,780,957 (13.16%) was also spent by local governments on roadway improvements.

### SFY2008-2011 TIP Status

In order to improve the use of the TIP as an effective management tool, the FTA and FHWA TIP guidelines require the TIP to note those projects whose implementation was delayed. In compliance with those guidelines, Table 3.4 includes SFY2008-2011 projects that experienced significant delays, or were upgraded from plan status to project status. It also shows the anticipated construction date, and reason for delay or change in status.

### Operation and Maintenance of Existing Transportation System

The TIP is required to demonstrate that, the existing transportation facilities are being adequately operated and maintained, by calculating the percent of total TIP expenditures for operation and maintenance projects. Annually MVRPC surveys all jurisdictions within the MPO boundary in order to compile a database of highway projects completed during the previous calendar year (See Table 3.1A and 3.2A). Expenditures for these projects are then summarized in Table 3.3A and 3.3B. From this information, MVRPC is able to generally track the type of projects and the amount of expenditures being used within the region. As part of our annual local jurisdiction project survey, we request each jurisdiction to estimate the amount of funds they spent on operation and maintenance versus capital improvements, in the previous calendar year. Table 3.5 summarizes the results of our survey. The analysis for 2009 showed that 59.80% of total local roadway and transit expenditures were for system preservation type projects. The total expenditures are broken down into two sections: 1). Roadway expenditures. 2). Transit expenditures. The analysis for 2009 also showed that 51.76% of roadway expenditures and 99.97% of transit expenditures were for system preservation type projects.

The analysis for 2010 showed that 66.31% of total local roadway and transit expenditures were for system preservation type projects. The analysis for 2010 also showed that 56.41% of roadway expenditures and 99.94% of transit expenditures were for system preservation type projects. As reflected above, the total local roadway and transit expenditures for system preservation type projects were very similar from 2009 to 2010. System preservation projects are essential to the long-term viability of the region's transportation system.

### Annual Listing of Projects

Table 3.6 includes a listing of projects for which federal funds are anticipated to be obligated during SFY2011.
