Subject: SFY2021-SFY2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #11

Over the last few months MVRPC and ODOT have made numerous modifications to the programming documents for various projects resulting in the need for an SFY2021-SFY2024 TIP amendment. The attached TIP Tables 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 reflect the updated information for each specific project. Modifications to Statewide Line Item projects are shown on Table 4.6 and are provided for information only. WHEREAS, MVRPC and ODOT have made numerous modifications to the programming documents for various projects resulting in the need for a SFY2021-SFY2024 TIP amendment; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment is consistent with the Region's long-range transportation plan; and

WHEREAS, this TIP amendment will not affect the regional air quality emission analysis of the SFY2021-SFY2024 TIP; and

WHEREAS, the MVRPC Public Participation Policy for Transportation Planning process allows for minor TIP amendments such as this to occur without separate public involvement meetings; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will result in a TIP that is in reasonable fiscal constraint
