



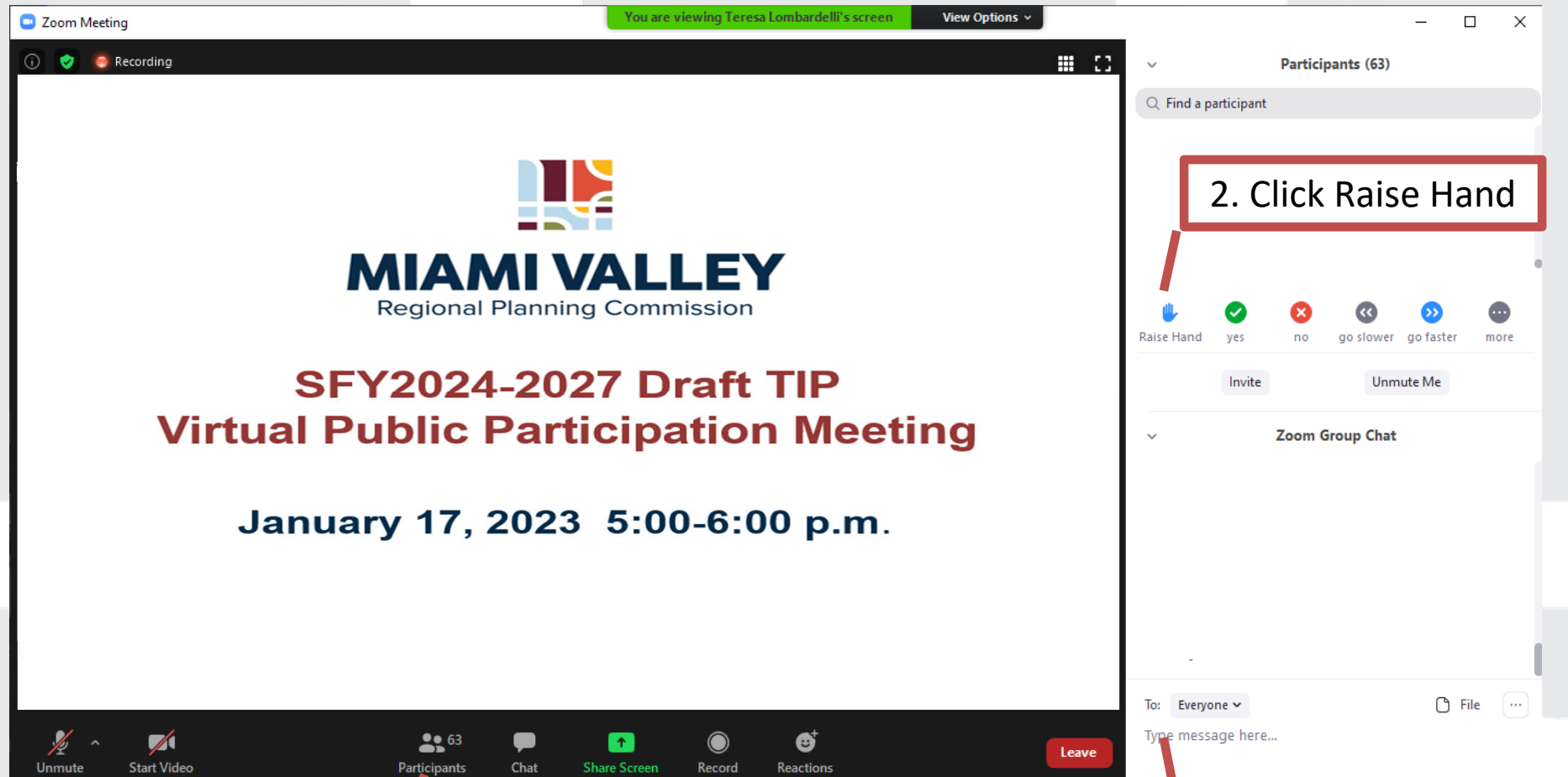

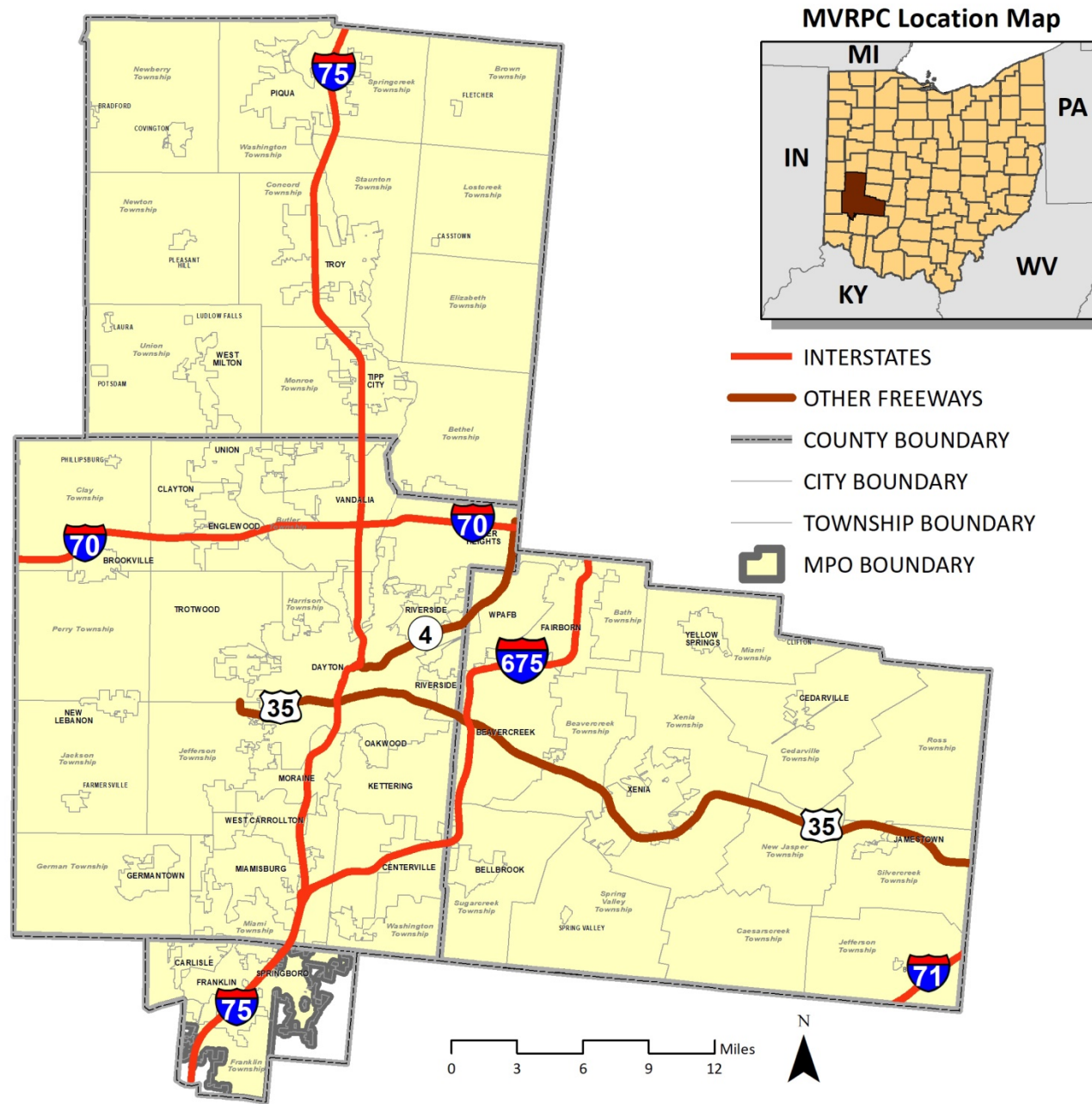

Draft SFY2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- **The previous TIP (SFY2021-2024) was adopted by the Board in May 2020.**
- **FHWA and FTA regulations require the development of a new TIP (SFY2024-2027)**
- **ODOT requires submittal of a Draft SFY2024-2027 TIP to ODOT Central by early February 2023.**
- **All roadway/bikeway/transit projects located within the MPO boundary utilizing federal funds in SFY2024-2027 must first be included in the TIP before a local jurisdiction can move forward with project implementation or construction.**

TIP Development Process

- **ODOT coordination and programming of all projects utilizing Federal funding in SFY2024-2027.**
- **MVRPC review of all projects programmed by ODOT and entry in to MVRPC's Web TELUS database.**
- **Development of TIP document including sections on: State and Federal TIP Requirements; Previous Years Accomplishments; Proposed Highway & Bikeway Improvements; Proposed Transit Improvements**
- **TIP public participation virtual meeting and comment period**

While MVRPC maintains a Long Range Transportation Plan that looks 26 years into the future, the Region also maintains a more detailed transportation capital improvement program that is updated every two years. Known as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), this short-range plan was updated in May 2020. The TIP lists transportation projects scheduled to be implemented over the next four years in Greene, Miami, Montgomery, and Warren Counties.

DRAFT SFY2024-2027 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Region's Long Range Transportation Plan is monitored and implemented through the TIP process. Specifically outlined in the TIP are the Region's highway, bikeway/pedestrian and transit improvements that are federally and/or state financed. Before local jurisdictions can move forward with any proposed project implementation or construction, that project must first gain approval for the use of federal or state dollars by MVRPC's Board of Directors and become a part of the TIP.

The Draft SFY2024 – 2027 TIP list includes road construction projects, bike/pedestrian projects, bus/transit and other transportation-related projects and services planned for SFY 2024-SFY2027 (four years: July 1, 2023– June 30, 2027).

The Final SFY2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is anticipated to be adopted in May 2023.
