A RESOLUTION BY THE MIAMI VALLEY DISASTER RECOVERY LEADERSHIP BOARD

In **SUPPORT** of the Long-Term Recovery Operations Network the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board was established in March, 2020 to guide and support the long-term recovery efforts in the Miami Valley after the 2019 Memorial Day tornadoes; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board focusing on jurisdictional and community recovery will transition to Phase II of recovery on January 1, 2023 to focus on resiliency and preparedness; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board will amend the current phases of work from three to two providing strategic leadership, oversight and transparency for the community on the long-term recovery efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board will reduce the number of annual meetings to twice per year for the first year of Phase II; and

WHEREAS, Current board member terms may remain effective for one additional year; and

WHEREAS, Current board members may resign from their commitments to serving the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board at any time; and

WHEREAS, community recovery will continue under the leadership of the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission and the Disaster Recovery Leadership Board being evaluated on an annual basis with meeting schedules and oversight adjusted accordingly; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Miami Valley Disaster Recovery Leadership Board recognizes that the result of successful strategic leadership and oversight has led to community recovery being accomplished earlier than originally anticipated and approves the revision of board timelines and phases.
