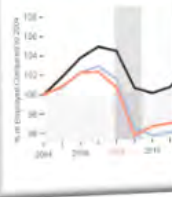

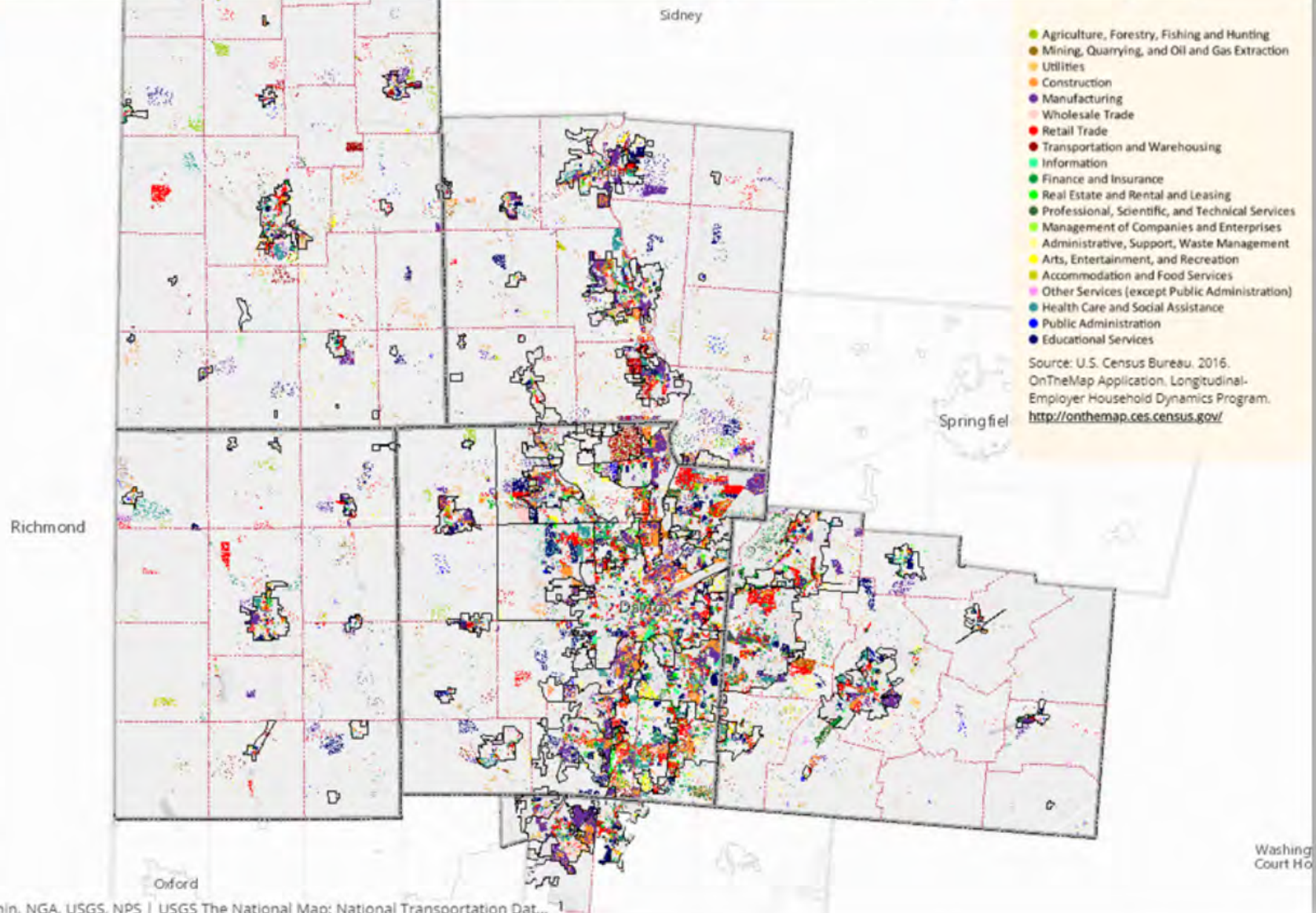

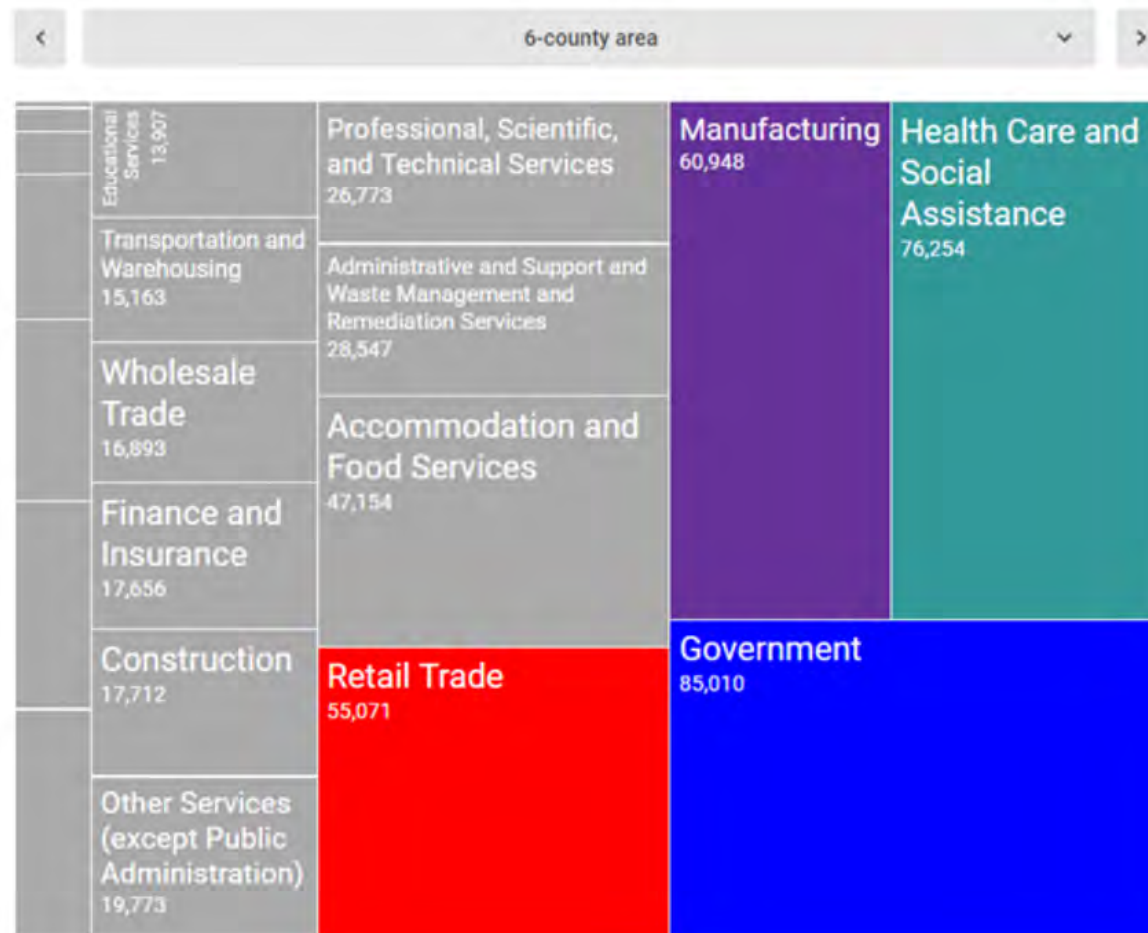

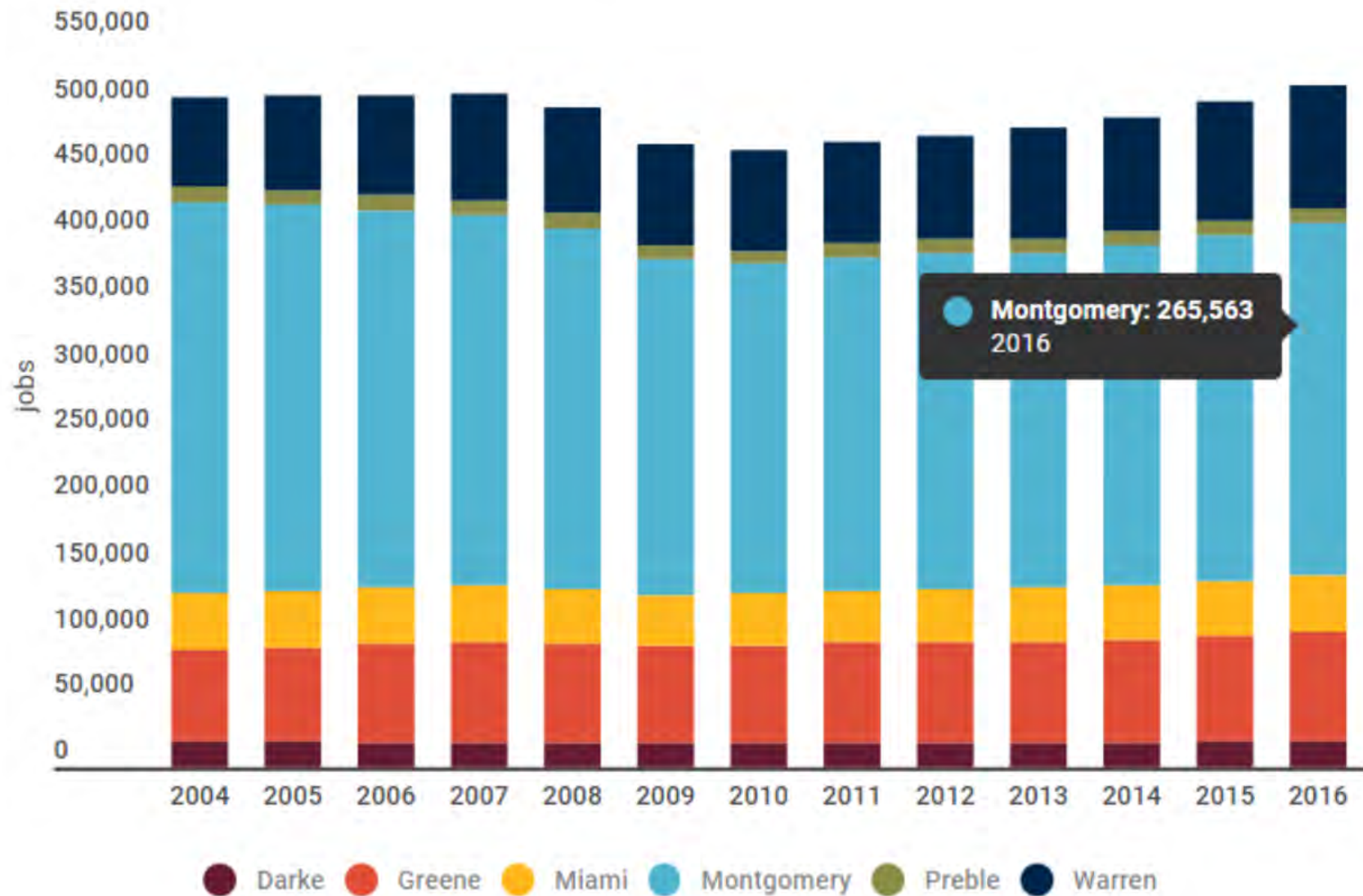
Our area's economy is dominated by government, health care, manufacturing, and retail sectors.

The largest sectors by employment are **government**, **health care**, **manufacturing**, and **retail**. Together, they account for 54% of the six-county area's jobs.

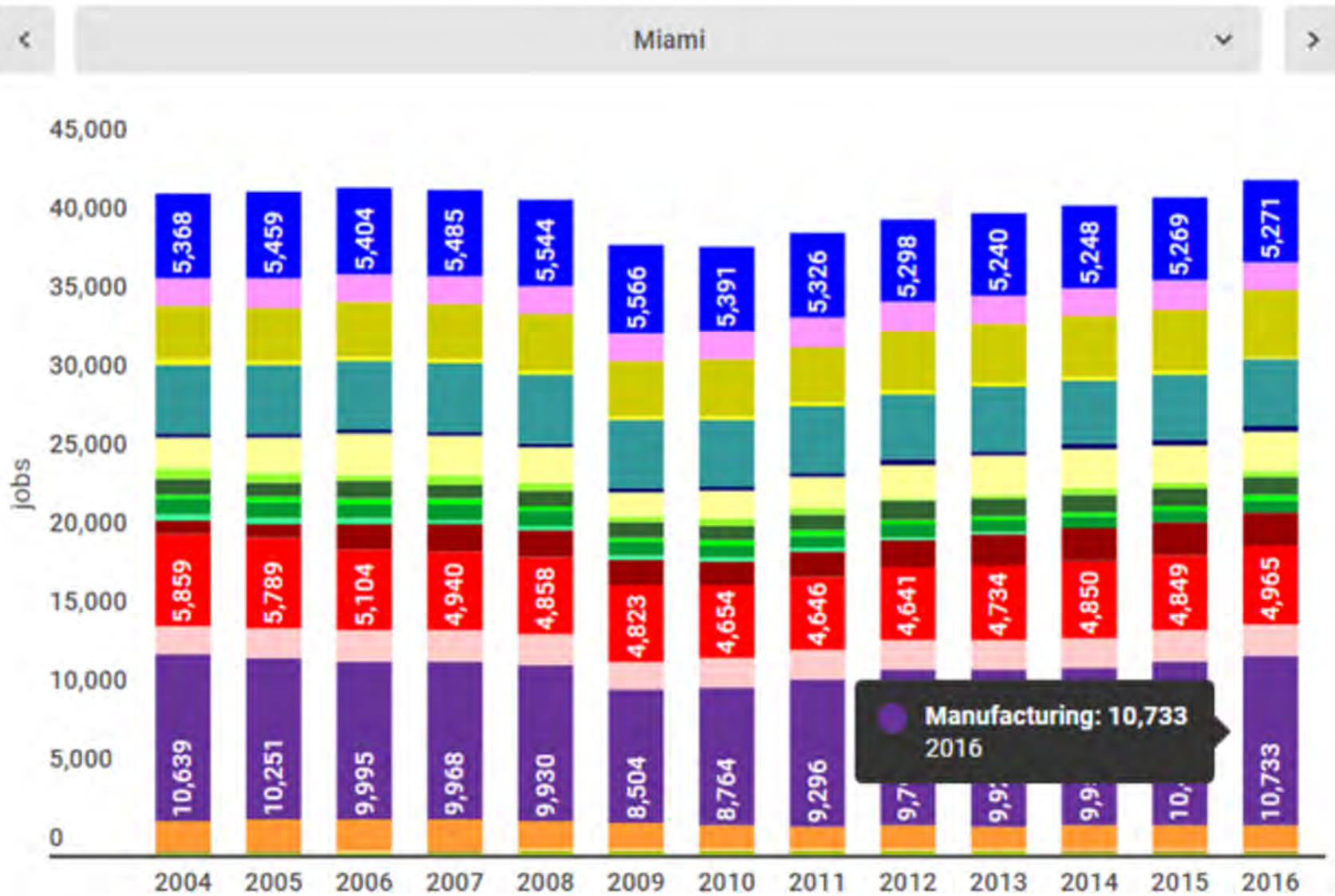
In all counties but Greene, these four sectors are also the largest, although in different orders. In Greene County, the top four sectors are government; retail; professional, scientific, and technical services; then accommodation & food services.

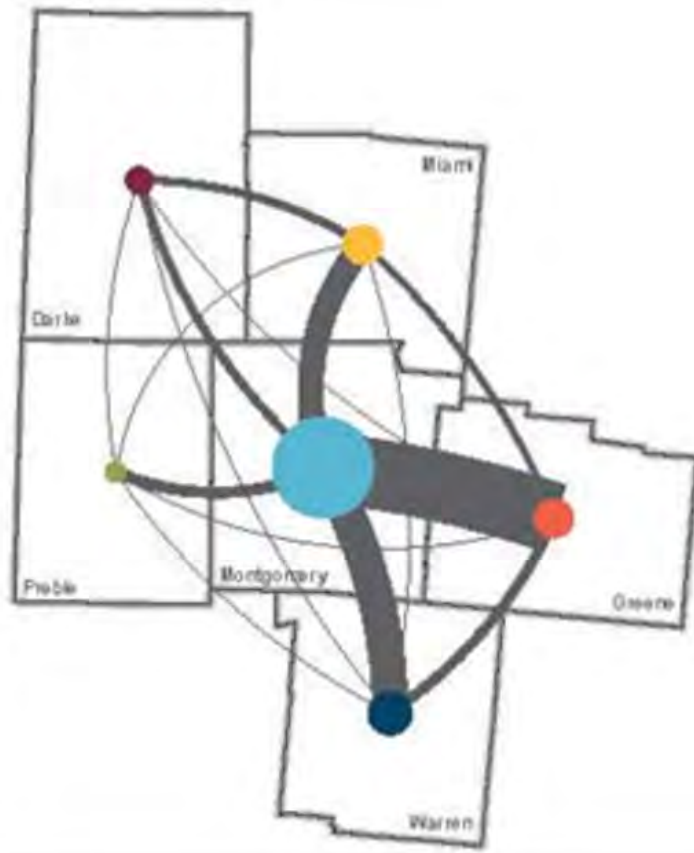


Jobs by county over time

Our Region's diverse workforce travels all around the six-county area to reach their workplace.

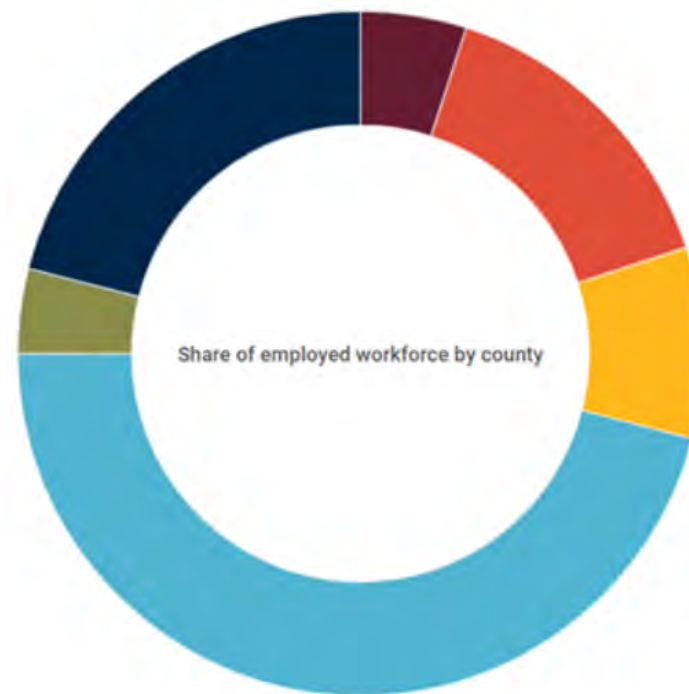
About a third of our residents leave the six-county area for work, but nearly as many come to work in our area from outside.

29% people who work in the six-county area live outside it.



32% people who live in the six-county area work outside it.

Montgomery County has the largest workforce in the Region, but it also has the highest unemployment rate. Greene County has the highest median hourly earnings of \$18.02.

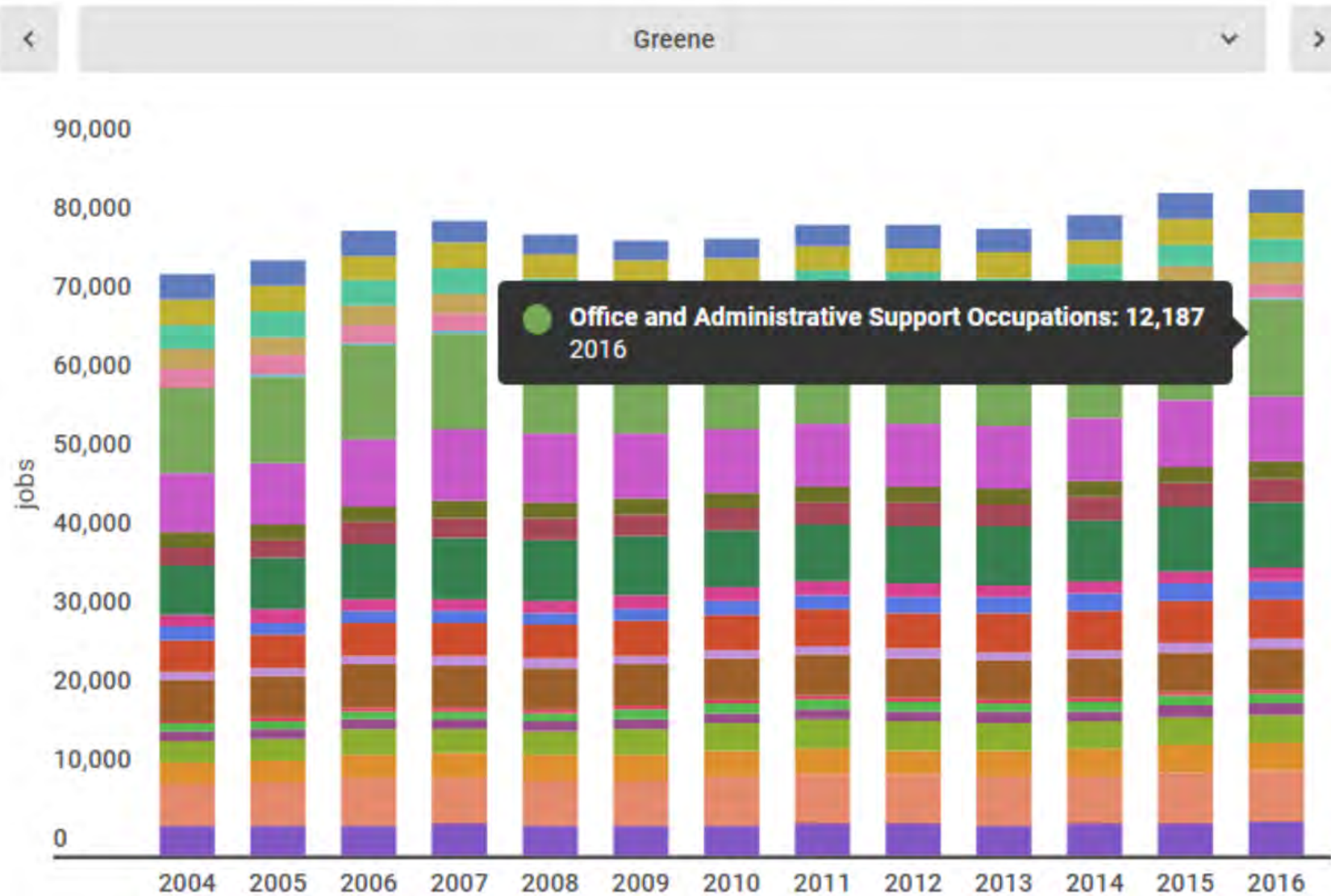

Our area's workforce is dominated by office, sales, food preparation, production, and healthcare occupations.

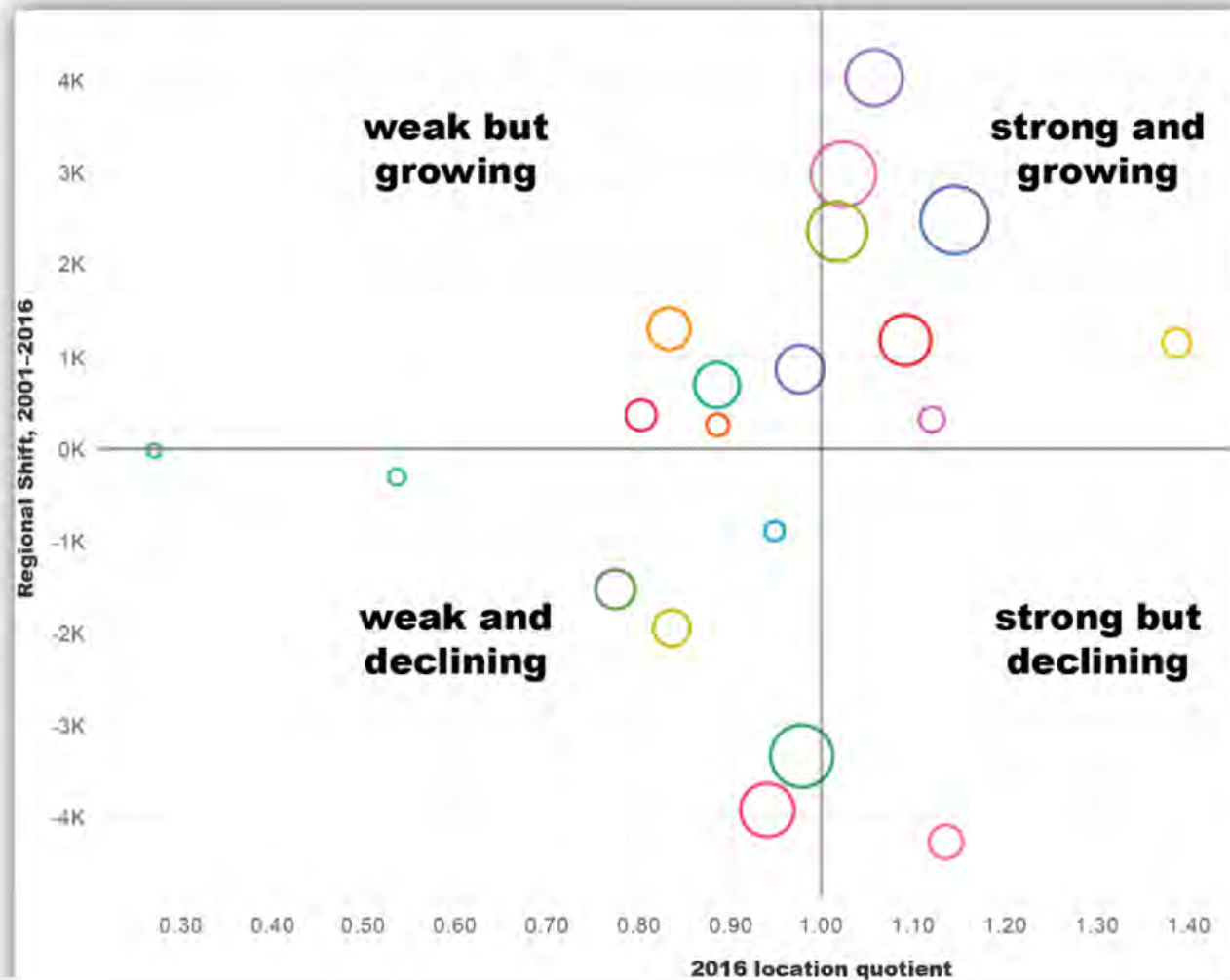

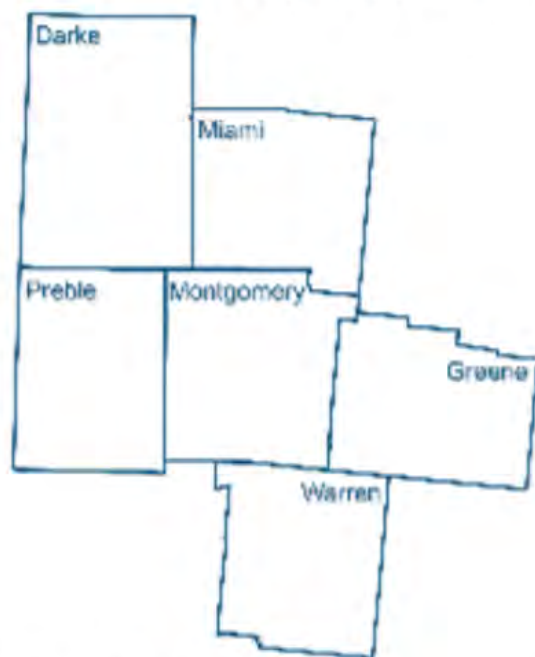
Jobs by occupational group over time

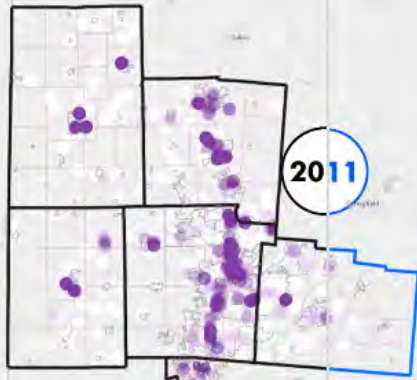
