## Background

Initiated as a two-year pilot project – funded by the Ohio Department of Transportation

Designed to enhance transportation connections for those unable to drive or do not have access to personal transportation

Goal #1: Develop a coordinated transportation plan to prepare for regionalizing the nine counties

Goal #2: Establish a strong and active regional coordination council



# Plan Development Timeline

---

- **August 2018 – April 2019** – Data collection, assessment of available services, community support, and transportation needs and gaps
- **June 2018 – July 2019** – GRMI Council meetings
- **March - June 2019** – Goals and strategies development
- **June 2019** – Draft plan submission to ODOT
- **July 9 & 11, 2019** – Public Participation meetings with open public comment period
- **August 1, 2019** – Draft plan presentation to Board of Directors
