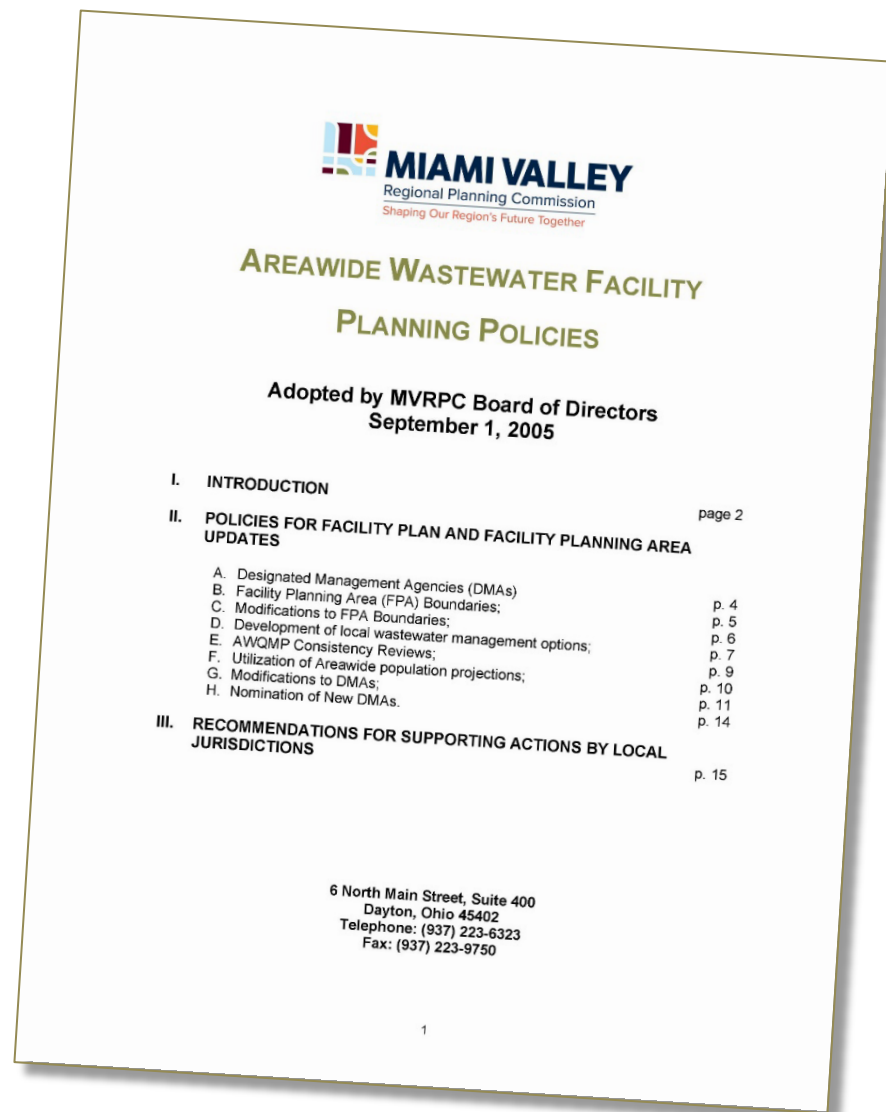

# Working Group Background

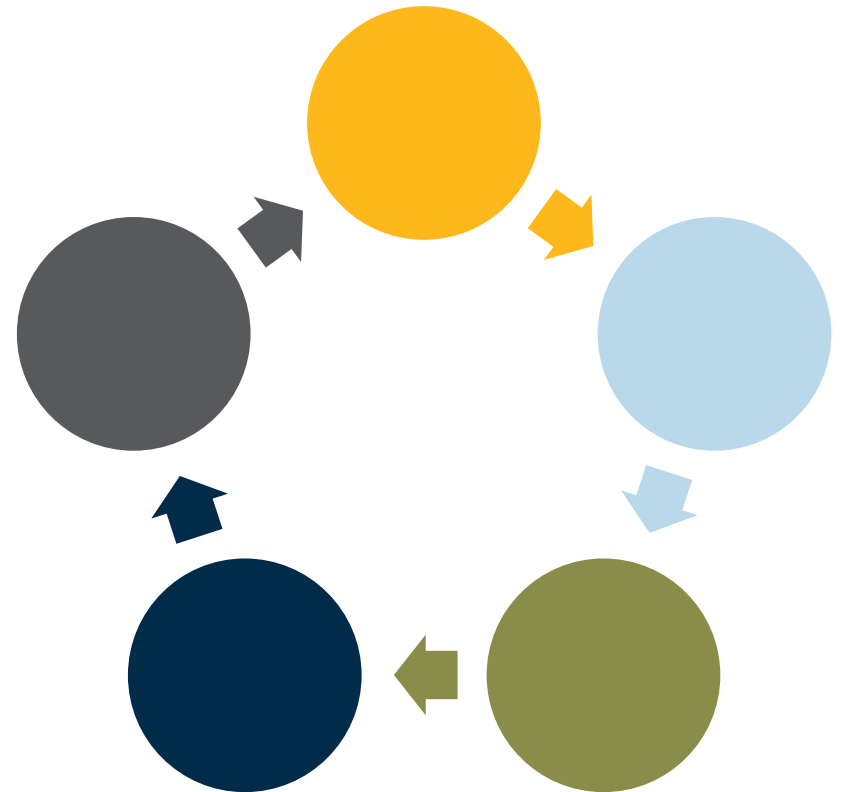
- Adopted in 2005
- Defines “Primary Designated Management Agency” (DMA) and “Satellite DMA.”
- Defines “Facility Planning Area” (FPA)
- **Describes the processes for modifications to DMAs and FPAs**



# Purpose of the FPA Policy Review Working Group

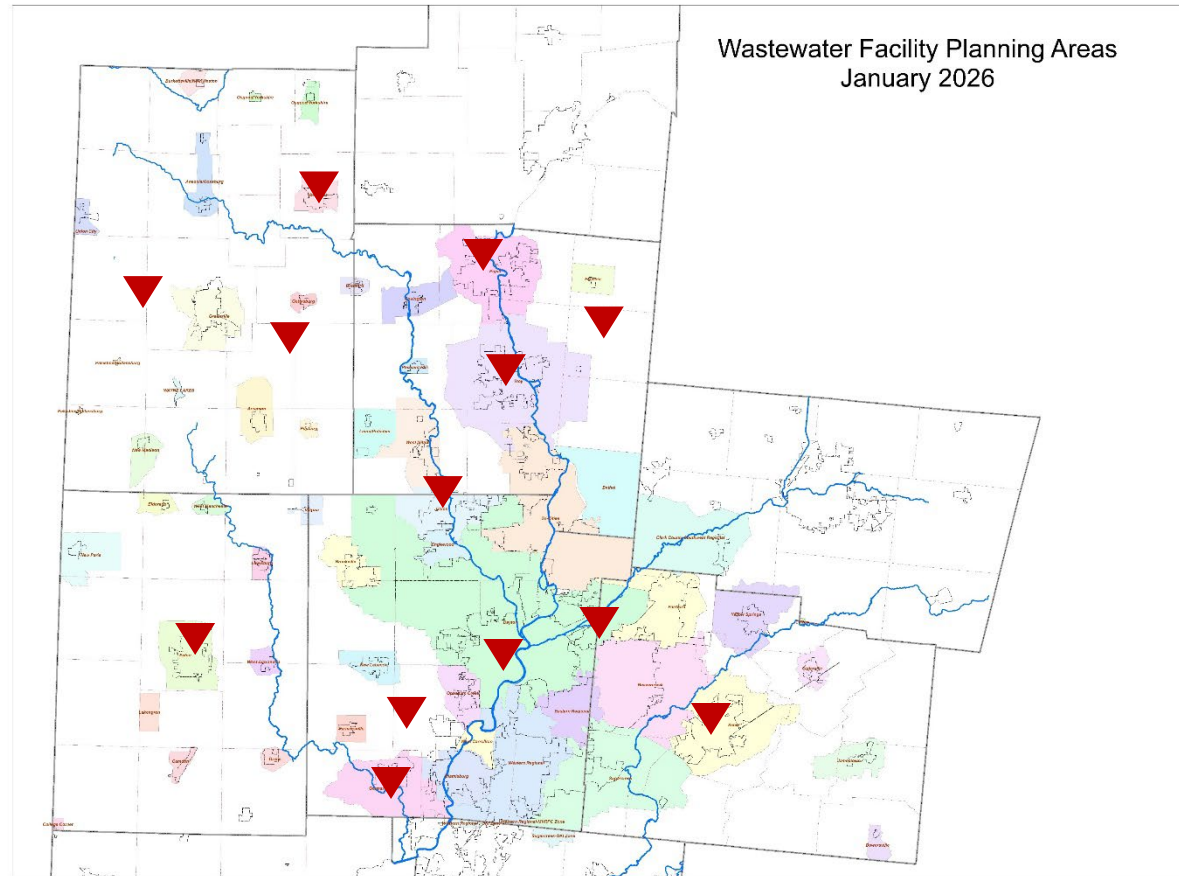
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- Review how the existing policies address FPA changes and how they work in actual practice.
- Identify ways the process could be improved.
- Propose changes to the policies for consideration.
- Fulfill a staff commitment to the Board of Directors.



# Working Group Formation

- Call for participants in January
- 14 working group members in February
  - 8 cities
  - 1 village
  - 2 counties
  - 2 Public Health Districts



- All five Water Quality Planning counties represented
- First meeting is set for March 24, 2026 in Clayton
