HSTC Plan Purpose

Overview

- To better serve people with unmet transportation needs such as older adults, individuals with disabilities, people with limited incomes
- To optimize resource allocation among human service, private and public transportation providers
- To prepare the Miami Valley to be more competitive for Federal transportation funds
- To meet FAST Act requirements

HSTC Plan Update

Outcomes

- An updated assessment of available transportation services including public, private, and nonprofits
- An updated assessment of transportation gaps and unmet needs
- Updated strategies, activities, and/or projects to address the identified gaps between current services and needs, as well as opportunities to achieve efficiencies in service delivery
 - Special emphasis placed on new and emerging technologies for scheduling and delivering transportation



HSTC Plan Update

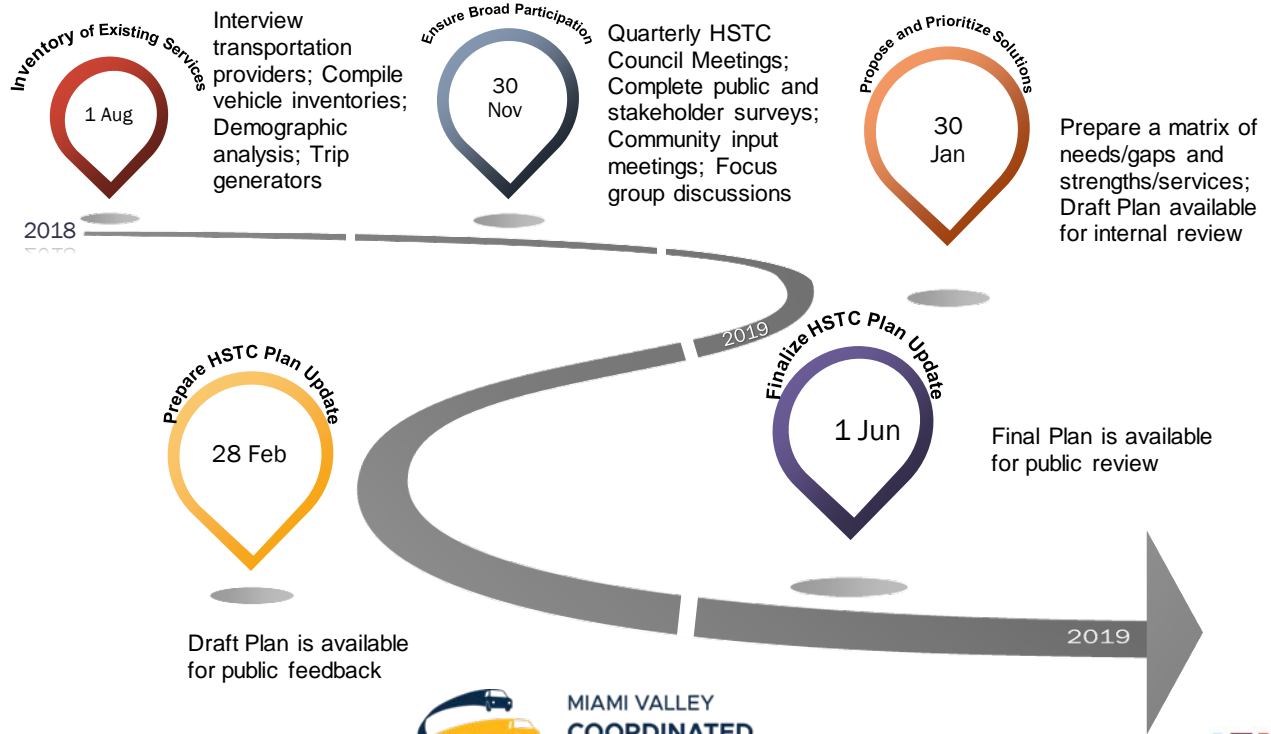
Outcomes
