<i>Planning/Preparedness</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Building relationships during ‘blue skies’ when a disaster or threat is not occurring • Evaluate federal, state, local partners • Establish recovery needs for each phase • Establish equipment & personnel needs for response 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community & recovery partners have been identified including volunteer networks • Federal, state, local funding partners have been identified • Recovery needs have been prioritized • Recovery plan has been created
<i>Short Term Response</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protective action for life-safety • Re-establish community lifelines • Gather initial impact information • Identify critical recovery properties • Reduce damage of built environment • Communicate additional short-term response actions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete life-safety measures • Community lifelines are partially or fully re-established • Complete initial damage assessment • Identification of immediate recovery objectives • Public & stakeholders are informed of recovery efforts
<i>Intermediate Response</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support immediate recovery needs of survivors • Make repairs to critical infrastructure • Direct recovery activities to Local Disaster Recovery Manager • Repair/rebuild homes, businesses and other facilities • Activate long term recovery operations groups 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Displaced residents are transitioned out of emergency shelters • Critical infrastructure is in process of being repaired • Operations have been successfully transitioned from local EMA • Property & business owners are in process of repairing/rebuilding • Key groups have been activated
<i>Long Term Response</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Satisfy recovery needs of survivors • Continue to repair/rebuild infrastructure & damaged structures • Review & develop long term recovery strategy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residents have returned to homes & businesses are fully open • Critical infrastructure is repaired and open to public use • Community is healthy and more resilient
