


2022 Headlines

Global Land and Ocean




- NOAA: 2022 was 6th warmest globally, 18th warmest for the US
- **EU**: March 2023 was 2nd warmest globally, 529th consecutive month above 20th century average






Precipitation



- NOAA: 2022 in the "drier third," with precip. down 1.6" on average in the US.
- MCD: MV precip. About 1.7" below 1991-2020 average



Non-carbon Sourced Electricity



- US: 39.7% + 1.3% from small scale solar. (Source: US EIA)
- EU: 52% from non-carbon sources



Reducing emissions from cars, buses and trucks




