




## Piqua FPA Amendment


# Current FPA boundaries for Troy and Piqua



The yellow area shown here are the parcels included in this amendment. This area was developed as a compromise between Piqua and Troy after an initial proposal that included more parcels in the Troy Facility Planning Area. This proposed change will cover areas already annexed into the City of Piqua, and that have been zoned for industrial development.




This would be the resulting FPA boundary should the amendment be approved. MVRPC staff have been informed that more annexations to the City of Piqua are anticipated and we can expect another request to update the boundary once those are completed.



# Review Process

- Initial request received from City of Piqua: March 2025
- Stakeholder meeting held on April 30, 2025
  - Compromise map developed
- Presentation to the WESC on May 14, 2025
- Public comment period: September 2025
  - Virtual Public Meeting: September 18, 2025
- MVRPC Technical Advisory Committee: November 20
- MVRPC Board of Directors: December 4


